Although volunteers do not move student belongings, they:

- Welcome students and supporters in the parking lots
- Direct people to check in and move in locations
- Help with recycling

For participating, volunteers may move in early, receive two free t-shirts and free breakfast and lunch on the days they volunteer. Volunteers are required to work one four-hour shift each day, Friday-Sunday. (three four-hour shifts).

Note: If you are participating in sorority recruitment you will not be able to volunteer. The schedules will not allow enough time for both opportunities.
