*Trailers and other oversized vehicles

We strongly discourage residents and supporters from bringing trailers and other oversized vehicles that will not fit in one parking space. Parking near the residence halls is limited and campus parking lots can be difficult to navigate when towing or backing trailers. This may result in having to park further away from your residence hall to unload.

Vehicles and vehicles towing trailers that cannot fit in one parking space are not permitted in long-term parking. Parking for these vehicles is available in the W17 parking lot near the corner of Hull Street and Broad Street. Space is designated for those who wish to drop their trailer and leave with their tow

vehicle and space for those who wish to leave both their tow vehicle and trailer or oversized in the parking lot. Please review the map below:
