Here are some ways University Housing is working to keep our residence halls secure:

- Secure, two-factor authentication entry points to the residence halls
- 24-hour desks
- Residence hall staff members on call after hours and on weekends to assist in case of an emergency
- Regular patrols by uniformed housing security members
- Interior and exterior security cameras to enhance surveillance and deter potential threats

Some ways you can help are:

- Maintain possession of your UGA ID and room key
- Lock your room doors
- Always escort your guests within the building
- Ensure exterior doors are not propped open
- Be mindful of who you allow into the buildings with you never hold the door open for someone you don't know
- If someone does follow you into the building and you don't feel comfortable confronting them, call the police, stop by the front desk or let your RA know
- Let the police or housing staff know if you see something or someone that you're concerned about

By working together, we can help create a supportive, thriving and secure community.
