The University of Georgia is pleased to welcome the ESPN College GameDay broadcast to campus in advance of Saturday's 3:30 p.m. football game against Ole Miss. ESPN College GameDay is a live, nationally broadcast pregame show focused on college football.

This Saturday's live broadcast will feature a live performance by Luke Combs and Bailey Zimmerman, likely between 10 a.m. and noon.

Standard gameday protocols will be in place:

- Locked exterior doors
- Security cameras to monitor interior and exterior spaces
- · Student and full-time staff on call
- Police on call to respond to emergencies

Because of the scope of the show, several areas will be impacted College GameDay's presence on campus:

- Myers Quad will be limited or inaccessible Wednesday morning through Sunday morning, and you can expect some noise as the set is built

 the public beginning at 5 p.m. Friday. If you leave these lots after that time, you may not find
 a space when you return
