Dear residents,

As part of a campus-wide initiative to enhance building security and personal safety, **all exterior secure access doors to residence halls will be locked 24/7 beginning Friday, Oct. 31 at 8 p.m.**

This change means that lobbies will no longer be publicly accessible during daytime hours, and all building access will require your UGAID and PIN at exterior entrances like the current weekend schedule. We believe this step will help create a more secure living environment for everyone in our community.

What to expect:

- Mail and package pickup: If you do not live in the building where your mail or packages are delivered, please bring your student ID, press the call button at the secure door and speak with the desk assistant at your community desk to be buzzed in to retrieve packages.
- Food delivery: Delivery drivers will be granted access to lobbies to place food on the provided shelves in view of the front desk.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work to make our residence halls more secure for everyone. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to reach out to your residence hall director.
